Recording Videos can create an additional way to connect with your students:

- Asynchronous materials for your curriculum
- Increase accessibility
- Reduce Barriers

How do you record these videos?

- Two features
 - Self-Service feature - Formerly known as One button
 - Lightboard
- Self-service
 - Traditional - Slides are presented in the back while you present in front
- Lightboard
 - Large glass panel in front
 - Slides are overlaid on the recorded video
 - Short learning curve with the one-hour workshop offered every quarter
